### **Monday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>: Knowledge Test and Group Activity**

FFA Knowledge Test – It will take place in the Mrs. Silcox's Room at 7:00 am. You will need to bring you laptop because the test is electronic. After the test all applicants will also participate in a group activity that will take 30 minutes.

Also on Monday you will need to hang up your campaign posters, one in each Ag. Class Room (Mrs. Silcox's classroom, Mr. Roath's classroom). They need to be up by 8:00 am, it is also first come first serve on hanging spots (so if you have a place in mind don't wait until eight) Your posters will need to include what you think is necessary to inform members on who you are and why you re the best candidate. It may NOT be larger than a regular poster.

### **Wednesday, May 5<sup>th</sup>: Chapter Vote –**

FFA Members will cast votes via Visual format for which applicants they think best fits the position.

### **Thursday, May 6<sup>th</sup>: Interviews**

As always there will be two interviews. The first interview is with Senior FFA Officers for a 10 minute interview. Just as we have done for years, the senior FFA officers get a chance to interview you! Also please come prepared with a unique item that best represents your strongest leadership quality. The second will be with an anonymous committee of people, for an another 10 minutes. There will be time sign-up sheets available on May 3<sup>rd</sup> (be sure to sign-up for different times). These interviews will take place May 6<sup>th</sup> starting at 5:00 pm. Please note if there is a conflict we are willing to be flexible. Official dress is required for this event.

### **Monday, May 17<sup>th</sup>: Chapter Awards Night Officers Announced –**

The new officers will be announced that the chapter awards nights. This new team will serve with the current team until the middle of May. Then we will retire and install in official ceremonies in May!
